



Can't Get to the Polls? Too Busy to Vote? In New Jersey, any voter can vote by mail for any reason or no reason at all using the Vote By Mail ballot. If you are a qualified and registered voter, then you may apply for a Vote By Mail ballot by completing the application and mailing to the address below. The deadline for such requests by mail is 7 days before any and all elections (Primary, General, School, etc). A Vote By Mail voter may also apply in person at the County Clerk's Office on any working day until 3:00 p.m. on the day before the election.....Mailing Address

May 13 Deadline for Change of Party Affiliation Declaration Forms for Primary Election to be Filed with County Commissioners of Registration (55 days before the election) N.J.S.A. 19:23-45

May 23 Commencement of Sending UOCAVA Ballots for Primary Election (45 days before election) N.J.S.A. 19:63-5, N.J.S.A. 19:63-9

May 30 Commencement of Mailing Regular Mail-In Ballots for Primary Election (38 days before election) N.J.S.A. 19:63-5, N.J.S.A. 19:63-9 (P.L.2020, c.5.)

June 16 Voter Registration Deadline for Primary Election (21 days before election) N.J.S.A. 19:31-6

June 30 Deadline to apply for a Mail-In Ballot by Mail for Primary Election (not less than 7 days prior to election) N.J.S.A. 19:63-3

July 1 Mailing of Sample Ballots for Primary Election (on or before 12 noon on Wednesday preceding election) N.J.S.A. 19:23-34

July 6 – by 3:00 p.m. Deadline for In-Person Mail-In Ballot Applications for Primary Election (up to 3:00 p.m. on the day before election) N.J.S.A. 19:63-3

July 7 Primary Election Day (Moved from the first Tuesday after the first Monday in June by Executive Order 120) N.J.S.A. 19:2-1, N.J.S.A. 19:23-40 (Executive Order 120)

July 7 Deadline for Post Office Receipt of Mail-In Ballots from the Primary Election

July 7 Deadline for in Person Submission of Primary Election Mail-In Ballots to County Boards of Election (by 8:00 p.m. on the day of election) N.J.S.A. 19:63-16

VOTE BY MAIL BALLOT REPORTS WILL NOW BE POSTED ON THE COUNTY CLERK'S WEBSITE

This new method of disseminating reports will provide users with up to date information that can be accessed using any device that has internet access such as smart phones, iPads, laptops, or desk top computers.

N.J.S.A. 19:63-10 – Distribution of list; public access to information

The County Clerk shall update vote by mail lists each business day and they shall be made available to the public.
